

Mr. Marsh's Classroom Rules and Procedures

Start of Class

1. Come prepared to class with all materials (ex. pencils, Chromebook, paper, and binder).
2. Come in quietly and grab the notes or activity that will be in the tray as you come in the door. Make sure you have your pencils sharpened before the class begins.
3. Open up Google Classroom on your Chromebook and check the day's announcement to find out what we will be doing that day. If there are problems of the week assigned begin working on those immediately.
4. Complete all work in **pencil!** (No pen!)

Disruptive Behavior & Cell Phone Policy

1. Disruptive behavior is not accepted in my classroom at all.
2. We are here to learn and I want to present the best learning environment possible to every student in the classroom.
3. Use your passing period and lunch for social time because Math class is not the time.
4. High School Only- If I see your cell phone out, I will take it to the office and you can get it back at the end of the day. Junior high students you will follow the handbook for what it says about cell phones.

In-Class Work

1. During any in-class work you will work individually, with partners, or in small groups. This time is to actively investigate the current topic. As the teacher I will be there to help you as you work through the activity. You need to use your partners or group members first (always check notes first as well). There is a reason I have you with them in specific activities.
2. You need to be active in your own learning. Ask questions! There are never any stupid questions. Do not be afraid to make mistakes when answering questions.
3. Always be respectful of what your classmates have to say when working with a partner or a group.
5. Work as a team. This does not mean Student A does 5 problems, Student B does 5 different problems and Student C does 5 other problems then you copy each other. Work together on each problem so you can ask a question if one person is unsure.

Class Discussions

1. RAISE YOUR HAND! Do not shout out answers! Give adequate time for everyone to think about the question.
2. If someone is speaking be polite and listen to what they have to say.
3. Participate!

Tardy's

1. When you are tardy in my class, I will let you know. 1st-3rd periods, you will be counted tardy if you are not in your seat when the bell rings. 4th-7th periods, you will be counted tardy if you are not in your seat when I close the door to begin class. I will let you know if I am marking you tardy and you will sign a tardy sheet.

Garbage

1. Collect the garbage and place it in the trash at the end of the period! Do not get up in the middle of class discussions or while we are going over problems to throw away a piece of paper.
2. No throwing garbage into the trash can; walk it over and place it in the trash. This is NOT gym class.
3. Keep my room clean and organized. Make less work for the janitors.

Emergency Drills

1. Stop what you are doing and listen for instructions.
2. Walk **SILENTLY** to the designated safe location.
3. Directions for Fire and Tornado drills are by the entrance to my classroom on the wall.

Leaving Class

1. You will be able to leave the classroom to use the restroom and see the nurse.
2. Get my permission to go to the restroom or nurse and I will write you a pass. You are **NOT** allowed to leave the classroom without a pass. If you are going to the restroom, grab the restroom pass and write your name on the white board.
3. Once I close my door for the period to begin you will not be able to go to your locker to retrieve any items that you should know to bring (Chromebooks, pencils, notebooks, **HOMEWORK!**).
4. Use your passing period wisely. If you need to use the restroom during the passing period, come see me right after your previous class. This will inform me of where you are going in case you are late. **DO NOT COME TO ME RIGHT BEFORE CLASS BEGINS AND ASK TO USE THE RESTROOM.** I will say **NO!**

In-Class Work/Binder

This will count for 15% of your 9 weeks grade. These are assignments that will be completed and turned in during class. These include classroom activities and review worksheets. This will also include a binder check after each unit to make sure you are staying organized. You need to keep anything we have done from that unit and it needs to stay in order.

Notes

As we go through notes, I will have you complete certain problems on your own. I will be walking around the class checking these problems. You will be doing these problems to check how well you understand the concept of the day's lesson. If you are absent on any given day, I will be posting your Lessons on my website and on Google Classroom. It is your responsibility to go to my website and copy the notes that you have missed into your notebook.

Quizzes

We will take at least 2 quizzes during each chapter and the quizzes will be worth a minimum of 20 points. There will be a chance for partial credit if work is shown and a simple mistake was made. **NO** partial credit for guessing! I also have quiz corrections

which you can earn back half of the credit you missed on a quiz. Quizzes will make up 25% of your 9 weeks grade.

Homework

Each homework assignment will be worth the 20 points. I will always grade 9 problems in the assignment and you will get 2 points for completing the entire worksheet. You will turn your homework in after I have gone over any questions on the given assignment. You need to do them all every night in order to be prepared for the quizzes and tests. When the homework is assigned you should write the assignment in your student handbook. It will also be posted on Google Classroom, my Website, and the Whiteboard so there are no excuses to not know what the assignment is for the given day. Homework will be worth 15% of your 9 weeks grade.

Tests

At the end of each unit there will be a chapter test given. Each test will be worth around 100 points. The rules for the quizzes also apply to the tests. There will be a chance for partial credit on certain problems as long as work has been shown. Tests will be worth 45% of your 9 weeks grade.

Absent Work

If you are absent, it is your responsibility to check Google Classroom or my website and collect whatever assignment you may have missed.
